Vorms It was over 2000 years ago that Jesus said, Peter; "...when thou art CONVERTED, STRENGTHEN thy brethren." LUKE 22:32. Are those words still meaningful today? Yes indeed! In fact, if every preacher and teacher would allow the Spirit of God to rest upon them, they too, can be a part of the: "STRENGTHENING, and the soul saving work! But, sad to say, there is one area where this is not the case, namely:

"The eating of unclean foods." Why? There are Pastors and teachers who are on the record saying: "God said, 'Peter, it is now ok to eat unclean meats'. Friends, this is one of the Devil's **LIES!** Hence, many teachers and preachers are no-longer in the **STRENGTHENING** work, but, the **DESTROYING work!** Why? The gospel according to other men's opinions, has taken the place of a 'thus said the Lord'. Yes, those who are being paid to: "Preach the word" are no longer preaching the **'whole truth!**' Hence, the "Bible is being treated as if it is a:

"BUFFET." Yes, many are taking what they want from the "Bible" leaving what they do not want. Thus, millions are in the: "...Midst of a 'rebellious house,' which have 'eyes to see, and see not;' they have 'ears to hear, and hear not:' For 'they [are] a rebellious house." EZEKIEL 12:2. Sobering!

Amazingly, the words of Ezekiel are being fulfilled today through Peter's vision! In truth, one who is 'in the Spirit' only need to read Acts Ch. 10, 11, and quickly, they would fully understand that Peter's vision was not about "clean and unclean foods" but, it is ALL about preaching the goodnews of the gospel to "every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people" for whom Christ died. Yes, it is true, that "...a voice (said) ...Rise, Peter; kill, and eat." Why, Peter, "...became very hungry, and **'would have eaten:'** But while they made ready, he **'fell into (what?) a TRANCE**, and while in this trance, Peter, "...saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: Wherein were all manner of four-footed beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air. And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat. Peter said, **OK Lord;** for I have eaten unclean foods before. **No-No,** my friend, Peter said: **"NOT SO, Lord, I HAVE NEVER EATEN ANY THING** that is **COMMON or UNCLEAN**, And the voice [spake] unto him (Peter) again the second time, What God hath CLEANSED, [that] call not thou COMMON." full-stop! Never ONCE, my friend, did God use the word: UNCLEAN! It was Peter who said: "I HAVE NEVER EATEN any thing that is COMMON or UNCLEAN." And rightly so, because one can read from Matthew to Revelation and neverever, would you come across one Biblical text where Peter or any of the other disciples of Jesus ate any unclean foods.

So the question remains, what was this vision all about? **People, my** friend, people! For recorded in the Holy Writ are these words: "Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision....men which were sent from Cornelius had made inquiry... And called, and asked...if....Peter, were lodged there. While Peter thought on the **vision**, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee. Arise therefore, and get thee down, and go with them, doubting nothing: For I (God) have sent them. So...Peter went down to the men and said, Behold, I am he whom ye seek: What [is] the cause wherefore ye are come? And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee. And on the morrow Peter went away with them...Andthey entered into Caesarea. And Cornelius waited for them, and had called together his kinsmen and near friends. And as Peter (the so-called first Pope) was coming in, Cornelius met him, and 'fell down at his feet, and worshipped [him].' But Peter (the so-called first Pope) took him up, saying, Stand up; I myself also am (God? No-No, I) am a MAN." Amen. And as he talked with him, he went in, and found many that were come together. And he said unto them, Ye know how that it is an **'unlawful thing for a MAN** that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation;' but God hath showed me (Peter) that I should not call any (pork, crab, conch, lobster and shrimp unclean), NO, my friend, God showed Peter he should not CALL ANY "MAN" COMMON or UNCLEAN." ACTS 10, 11. Friends, the CLEANSING blood of Jesus Christ is for "You and I", not unclean foods, AMEN!

MEAT AND COLON CANCER PART 5

The colon cancer studies mentioned thus far have been done on women. Studies in men have also linked meat intake with colon cancer. For example, the same Harvard research group used similar methodology to look at colon cancer cases in their male health professional study. They discovered some striking dietary relationships by analyzing all new cases of colon cancer among the nearly 50,000 men in the study. Those eating red meat as a main among the nearly 50,000 men in the study. Those eating red meat as a main dish five or more times per week had a 3.5 times increased risk of colon cancer when compared to those avoiding these foods (eating them less than once per month)...
